


Beauty Parlor Setup \$1975

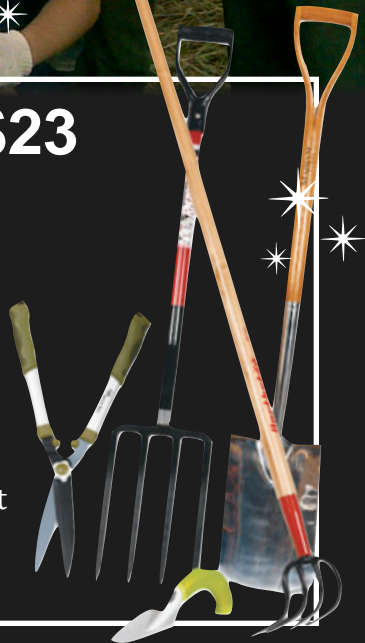


Gardening Tools \$23

“If you find any hope ...”

Although Vsevolod was born to a successful family in eastern Kazakhstan, he still lacked something. Not knowing how to fill the void in his life, he tried marijuana, then opium and soon became an addict. Over the next 12 years his life was a vicious cycle of addiction – every moment spent stealing, working, lying – anything for the drug. His parents sent him to several different hospitals and various religious groups and witches, but nothing helped.

When a friend heard of a rehabilitation center and decided to go, Vsevolod told him, *“If you find any hope, please write or call me. Find any way to tell me.”*

Weeks passed before Vsevolod found his way to the same center.

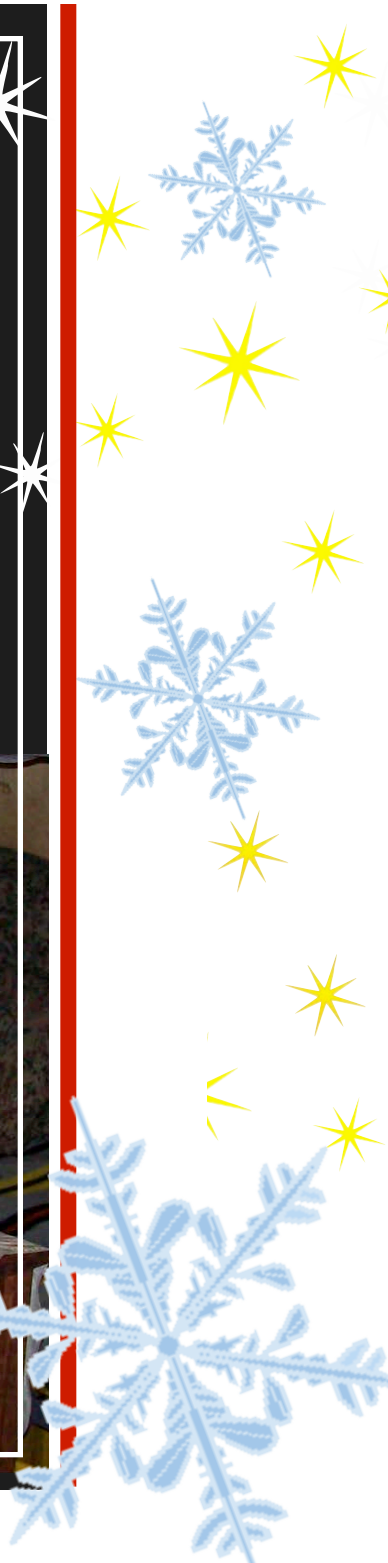


Pots/Pans \$25

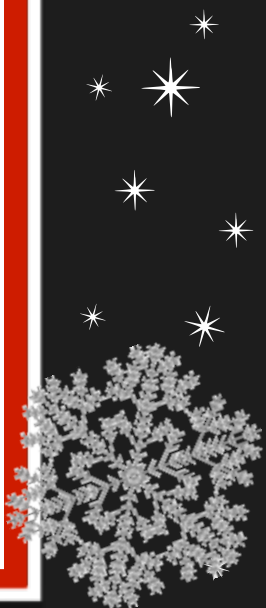


Bunk Bed/ Foam Mattress \$140

Equip for the harvest

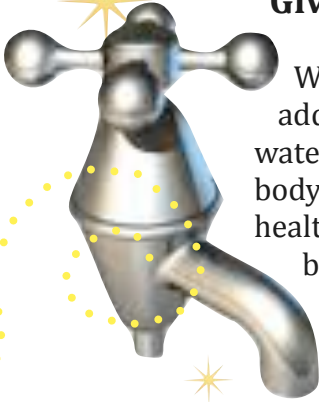

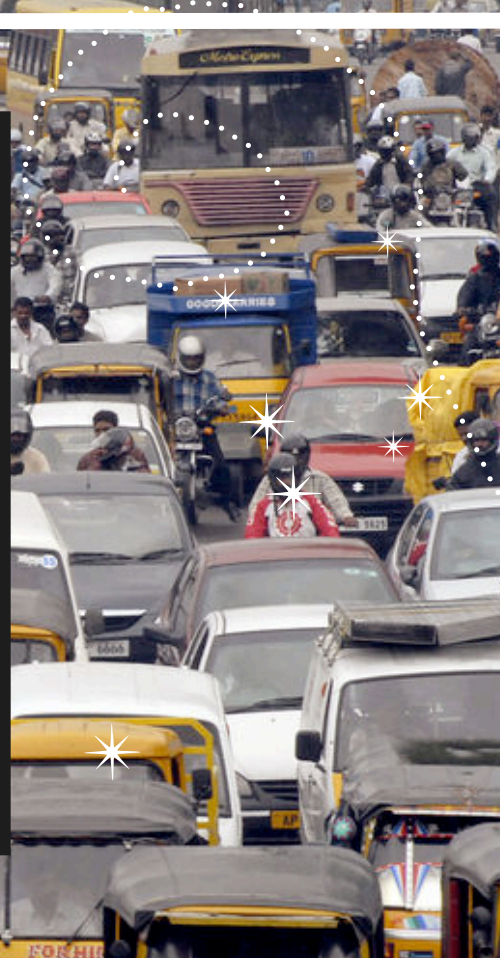


Driving Lessons for Staff \$40

Our History

In February 1958, David Wilkerson, a 26-year-old preacher disrupted a highly publicized murder trial in New York City. Why? To speak to the seven accused gang members about their salvation. News media were everywhere, and Wilkerson unwittingly made himself the source of headline news throughout New York City.

Wilkerson is known as the founder of an international drug rehabilitation program called Teen Challenge that has one of the highest success rates anywhere in the world. Since its first center opened in New York in 1960, Teen Challenge has grown to over 1060 centers in 82 countries.
